 - In relation to any election for which the chairperson is a nominee; or
 - Where a conflict of interest exists.
- Voting at the AGM;
 - Each Individual in attendance shall be entitled to one vote.
 - Any resolution put to the vote of the meeting shall be decided on a show of hands unless a poll is demanded by;
 - the chairperson; or
 - a simple majority of the attendees.
- If a poll is duly demanded it shall be taken in such a manner and either at once or after an interval or adjournment or otherwise as the chairperson directs. The result of the poll shall be the resolution of the meeting.
- Where voting is equal, the chairperson may exercise a casting vote. If the chairperson does not exercise a casting vote the motion will be lost.
- Proxy Votes are not permitted at this AGM.
- Any Motions or Amendments should be e-mailed no later than **5pm 17 October 2021** prior to the AGM, where possible, to the President, Paul Trunoff (sydney@rfcsupportergroup.com) in preparation for the AGM.
- Any other Motions or Amendments raised at the meeting will only be discussed time permitting and at the discretion of the Chair.
- No business other than that stated on this Agenda shall be transacted at this meeting
- It is a requirement of RFC & SRT that committee members need to be RFC members (any level).
